<u>DUTIES</u> :	This is moderately difficult work in the pruning, trimming, removing, transplanting and felling of trees. This position is usually preceded by Tree Trimmer Trainee, but not always. The employee is also capable of performing all task required of a Heavy Equipment Operator. Direct supervision is given from the Tree Crew Leader, then the assigned Public Works Supervisor, with general supervision by the Director of the Streets and Parks
MINIMUM QUALIFICATION	S : Candidates must meet the following either on or before the date of the written examination:
	 a) Three (3) years of experience as a tree trimmer trainee or equivalent; OR b) Possession of a valid NYS Commercial Driver's License for no less than 6 months; OR c) An equivalent combination of training and experience as stated above; and d) Demonstrate knowledge of tree removal and of roping techniques used to safely feel trees.
	Special Requirement: Possession of a CDL at the time of appointment and throughout the time of service with the City of Lockport
SUBJECT OF EXAM:	Written examination will cover knowledge, skills and abilities in such areas as:
	Tree felling, removing, spraying, and trimming These questions test for knowledge of the principles and practices involved in pruning, trimming, felling, and removing trees; proper spraying procedures for applying pesticides; and safe operating procedures.
	Tree and shrub planting, cultivating, transplanting, and pruning, including identification and characteristics of trees common to NYS These questions test for knowledge of the principles, practices, and proper techniques involved in planting, cultivating, transplanting, and pruning trees and shrubs; and the ability to identify various types of trees and woody plants common to New York State, including their characteristics and site requirements.
	Tools, equipment, terminology, and safety practices related to the care and removal

of trees

These questions test for knowledge of the proper use and maintenance of the various types of tools and equipment involved in the care and removal of trees, including safe operating practices.

Test guide:
