 - Update on lateral transfer firefighters-the two new firefighters are already making a positive difference. Comm. Morello spoke of three

other out-of-state firefighters who are interested in a transfer to Lockport. They learned of the opportunity on the NYSPFF website

- Probationary Firefighter Weber will graduate from the academy on July 24th.
- The LFD Engine Company quartered at South Lockport Fire Company will return to One Locks Plaza on July 15th. Comm. Schratz expressed thanks to South Lockport for accommodating LFD. Chief Brady indicated only one mutual aid call during the time LFD quartered at South Lockport Fire Company.
- Recent promotions have reduced the need for overtime. Chief Brady said the overtime budget for 2020 is just over \$66,000
- The LFD 2021 budget is a work in progress and is due by July 31st. Mayor Roman said the budget process this year is more itemized than in the past and is therefore a more comprehensive undertaking.
- FEMA grant announcements are expected this summer. Chief Brady has not yet heard anything with regard to any of the three grants. No test results have been received from promotional exams, and no indication when the firefighter exam will be held-awaiting word of an exact date.
