Chief Abbott's Report:

- Introduction of new SRO Justin O'Connor to the board: SRO O'Connor said he was excited to be working with the students, and wants them to know he's approachable. Chief Abbott said SRO O'Connor will be in full uniform at the school, and his appointment is for a four-year period. Chief Abbott said LPD is working with the school district on establishing a second SRO for next year
- Ride Along: Chief Abbott urged the members of the board to schedule a
 date and time to ride along with LPD officers to gain better perspective
 of the job. He said it is important experience for board members,
 especially when they need to make formal decisions regarding
 departmental policies and procedures

- CompStat Report for July, 2021: Calls for service were up by 300 over July, 2020. There were 55 custodial arrests, with 37 warrants of arrest issued and 13 parties arrested. Robberies, aggravated assaults, burglaries, larcenies and motor vehicle thefts were all down compared to July, 2020. Chief Abbott noted that all the suspects in the Farewell case have plead.
- Financial Update: Overtime is about \$35,000 below this time last year, although salaries showed an increase. Chief Abbott said the academy starts Sept. 13th
