PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that KRISTINA HARRIS hereby presents this Notice of Claim in accordance with General Municipal Law Section 50, New York Public Authorities Law § 1299-P, and makes claim against the Respondents, CITY OF LOCKPORT, COUNTY OF NIAGARA, and CITY OF LOCKPORT PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT and in support thereof alleges:

1. The name of the Claimant is KRISTINA HARRIS, hereinafter referred to as "Claimant" and "KRISTINA HARRIS," and she resides at 8 Bristol Avenue Lockport, NY 14094.

The attorneys for the Claimant are WILLIAM MATTAR, P.C. 6720 Main Street, Suite 100, Williamsville, NY 14221

- 2. The nature of the Claim is one to recover for damages for personal injuries, past, present and future pain and suffering, past and future medical costs, lost wages, change of lifestyle, loss of enjoyment of life, general and special damages, and all other damages allowed by law resulting from the injuries suffered by the Claimant, KRISTINA HARRIS, as a result of the negligence of the CITY OF LOCKPORT, COUNTY OF NIAGARA, and CITY OF LOCKPORT PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT, its servants, agents or employees in creating along with the other acts of negligence, carelessness and recklessness.
- 3. The incident which forms the basis for the Claim herein occurred at a traffic light at the intersection of West Genesee Street and Prospect Street in the City of Lockport, County of Niagara and State of New York.
- 4. On that date, KRISTINA HARRIS's vehicle was stopped at a red light when she was rear-ended by a dump truck operated by David A. Yourdon, and owned by City of Lockport.
- 5. That the Claimant's injuries occurred as a result of the negligence, carelessness, and reckless disregard for the safety of others including Claimant, KRISTINA HARRIS, by the CITY OF LOCKPORT, COUNTY OF NIAGARA, and CITY OF LOCKPORT PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT, its servants, agents or employees in creating along with the other acts of negligence, carelessness and recklessness.
- 6. That the aforesaid Respondents by and through their agents, servants and employees failed to perform proper recruiting and evaluation of drivers that includes new driver background

checks and qualifications, and provide adequate training and supervision of truck and motor vehicle drivers.

- 7. That as a result of the foregoing, the Claimant, KRISTINA HARRIS, sustained very serious injuries, including, among others, whiplash, left shoulder pain, spot on her brain and headaches. Some of these injuries will be of a permanent or indefinite duration, and Claimant, KRISTINA HARRIS, has and will, in the future be forced to expend sums of money for hospitals, doctors and other medical expenses.
- 8. That the said injuries were occasioned as a result of the negligence of the CITY OF LOCKPORT, COUNTY OF NIAGARA, and CITY OF LOCKPORT PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT, and through its agents, servants and employees and without any negligence on the part of the Claimant contributing thereto.

WHEREFORE, Claimant, KRISTINA HARRIS requests that her claim be allowed and paid by each of the Respondents.
