Lt. Pittman Announced a quorum had been met.

Lt. Pittman : The committee will ask Gina Pascieri to report to the Common Council that the Traffic Advisory Committee has reviewed all the options as presented to us on suggested improvements to the intersection of Locust St and Lincoln Ave. near the High School. The committee recommends that the City progress with what was called the "Caddillac Plan" for this intersection. This plan hopefully addresses the pedestrian as well as traffic flow issues identified at this intersection, including the timed crossing lights, right turn arrows and turning lanes.

Lt. Pittman read a letter received by the Mayors office from a Karen Baker of Heather Drive in the Town of Lockport. Ms. Baker requested that Deer Crossing signs be placed at all entrances to the city, referring to a handful of car/deer accidents that had taken place. After some discussion on the cost of the signs and installation and maintenance of the signs and the benefit of such signs, a motion was made by LFD Chief Quagliano to not install the signs. Seconded by M. Tracy.

Lt. Pittman: Read a letter from a resident of Park Place. Resident requested that a "Left Turn Green Arrow" be installed at the Intersection of Main St. and Locust St (for northbound traffic on Locust) After some discussion, it was determined that Locust St. northbound at main is single lane and with parking at the curb, there would not be enough room for northbound traffic to await the green signal or make a right on red.
