On the evening of August 2nd, 2022, officials from Wrights Corners Fire Company, South Lockport Fire Company, Rapids Fire Company, Cambria Fire Company, and Tri-Town Ambulance met with Chief Luca Quagliano of the City of Lockport Fire Department. During this meeting we discussed the recent over utilization of EMS mutual aid in the City of Lockport. This year we have noticed a substantial increase in the number of mutual aid requests to the city. The overuse of the mutual aid system is not sustainable. It is our goal to work with all parties to develop and implement a long-term sustainable model that is in the best interest of the community.

Currently, we have noticed that Mercy EMS is being sent into the city frequently, which in return leaves the surrounding communities without any reliable Paramedic Level of Emergency Medical Services. When the paid services (Mercy EMS, Twin City) are unavailable or on a delayed response, the surrounding volunteer ambulances are being requested via mutual aid to the City of Lockport. This has been happening too frequently and is what prompted our meeting and this letter.

Unfortunately, our agencies do not have an overwhelming volunteer roster. The providers we do have are needed to staff the ambulance to service our own districts. When our ambulances are requested into the city, that leaves our primary district potentially uncovered for a lengthy amount of time. The routine and frequent mutual aid requests into the city are leading to burnout of our providers. In a time where the number of volunteers is dwindling, it is our duty to protect our crews from burnout.

So ,Traffic should have been routed from Rt 78 (Truck Route) onto RT 31 (Truck Route) to Cold Springs Rd to Rt 78. This truck route is being used by trucks today. Nussbaumer & Clarke, Inc. (Nussbaumer) appreciates this opportunity to submit our request for a Contract Amendment for additional General Services During Construction (GSDC) and Construction Observation related to the referenced project. As you are aware, the various construction contractors have experienced unanticipated delays in equipment procurement and delivery due to the pandemic, which has extended the completion date of the project. As a result, additional GSDC and Construction Observation effort is required by Nussbaumer to coordinate and monitor the contractor's efforts.

We offer the following background information in support of this request;

- The City RFP for Engineering Services related to the UV project was due June 28, 2019. The RFP requested that proposers include 800 hours (approximately five months) of inspection time in their fee proposal and associated GSDC services.
- Nussbaumer entered into contact with the City for the project on August 26, 2019. Our contract included the requested five months of inspection (\$68,000.00) and GSDC services (\$25,100.00).
- Construction contractors (General and Electrical) were obtained by bidding and issued a
 Notice to Proceed on October 13, 2021. By Contract, the Contractors were given 150 calendar
 days (five months) to complete the project in advance of the NYSDEC permit required
 completion date of May 2022. Due to impacts caused by the pandemic, the NYSDEC extended
 the allowable completion date by 1 year to May 2023.
- The contractors have been significantly impacted by delays caused by equipment production and delivery. They have continued to make steady construction progress, however the disruption in the sequence of construction has had significant adverse impact on the schedule.
- The contractors are currently anticipating substantial completion of the project by November 2022.

- The overall project budget was prepared with an additional contingency of \$221,350.00.

General Services During Construction \$27,000.00 Construction Observation \$70,000.00

With the inclusion of the fees requested above, Nussbaumer's total fees will represent less than 8% of the total project cost.
