Chief Abbott's Report:

- <u>CompStat Report</u>: In November: 765 Blotters were filed, 154 Case reports were filed, 57 custodial arrests. Significant events included: Shots fired in Hawley Street Area, There were seven parties involved including a juvenile inside the vehicle. 22 shell casings were located at the site, all parties arrested. Armed Robery led to police chase. Motor vehicle accident at the corner of S Transit and Walnut involving a pedestrian, still under investigation, victim stated that he was walking across the street not where designated as a crosswalk. Male displaying handgun, arrested for Criminal Possession of Weapon and Menacing. Overdose call which resulted in officers finding male unresponsive. Case under investigation. During the month of November there were seven overdoses which is an increase.
  - Transported a person with a paramedic in the police car when there was a person experiencing a medical circumstance which required transportation to the hospital. Through this, we learned that a member of the LFD cannot travel in a LPD car, this is a liability concern.
  - Discussion took place about the challenges that are being faced by the LPD due to the lack of ambulance services.
- <u>COVID-19 Update</u>: Currently no one in the LPD has COVID.
