RESOLUTION URGING THE STATE TO ENACT MEASURES TO PROTECT FIRST RESPONDERS AND CHILDREN FROM ACCIDENTAL ILLEGAL DRUG OVERDOSES		
<b>WHEREAS</b> , in the past few years, the City of Lockport, like many other municipalities, have endured a spike in illegal opioid related overdoses and deaths; and		
<b>WHEREAS</b> , often first responders are exposed to illegal opioids while responding to emergencies; and		
<b>WHEREAS</b> , recently, three Lockport first responders were injured due to exposures to illegal opioids whereby emergency naloxone was administered to the first responders; and		
<b>WHEREAS</b> , children have also been the victim of exposure to illegal opioids due to drug use or drug residue in their immediate vicinity; and		
<b>WHEREAS</b> , some children have suffered overdoses or other injuries due to the exposure to illegal opioids; and		
<b>WHEREAS</b> , first responders, children and people not using illegal opioids need to be protected from harmful and dangerous exposure to opioids, drug paraphernalia and residue; and		
NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT		
<b>RESOLVED</b> , that the City of Lockport Common Council urges the New York State Legislature and Governor Kathy Hochul to enact strong legislation and criminal sanctions to curb the exposure of illegal opioid residue to first responders, children and people not using illegal opioids; and be it further		
<b>RESOLVED</b> , that the City of Lockport Common Council urges Senator Rob Ortt and Assemblyman Michael Norris to sponsor legislation intended to address this very serious issue; and be it further		
<b>RESOLVED</b> , that certified copies of this resolution be forwarded to Senator Rob Ortt, Assemblyman Michael Norris, Governor Kathy Hochul, and any other elected official deemed necessary and proper.
