RESOLUTION URGING THE STATE TO ENACT MEASURES TO PROTECT FIRST RESPONDERS AND CHILDREN FROM ACCIDENTAL ILLEGAL DRUG OVERDOSES

WHEREAS, in the past few years, the City of Lockport, like many other municipalities, have endured a spike in illegal opioid related overdoses and deaths; and

WHEREAS, often first responders are exposed to illegal opioids while responding to emergencies; and

WHEREAS, recently, three Lockport first responders were injured due to exposures to illegal opioids whereby emergency naloxone was administered to the first responders; and

WHEREAS, children have also been the victim of exposure to illegal opioids due to drug use or drug residue in their immediate vicinity; and

WHEREAS, some children have suffered overdoses or other injuries due to the exposure to illegal opioids; and

WHEREAS, first responders, children and people not using illegal opioids need to be protected from harmful and dangerous exposure to opioids, drug paraphernalia and residue; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT

RESOLVED, that the City of Lockport Common Council urges the New York State Legislature and Governor Kathy Hochul to enact strong legislation and criminal sanctions to curb the exposure of illegal opioid residue to first responders, children and people not using illegal opioids; and be it further

RESOLVED, that the City of Lockport Common Council urges Senator Rob Ortt and Assemblyman Michael Norris to sponsor legislation intended to address this very serious issue; and be it further

RESOLVED, that certified copies of this resolution be forwarded to Senator Rob Ortt, Assemblyman Michael Norris, Governor Kathy Hochul, and any other elected official deemed necessary and proper.

I have notified the City of Lockport on numerous occasions about the tree at the above mention properties, to this date only two trees have been removed, and one tree did it on its own. But the stump is still there at 156 Vine St. (See attached photo's).

7 Priscilla Ln – Has 2 trees in the front yard that have to come down, the roots from these trees are growing above ground causing a very serious tripping hazard. (See attached photo's). Also, the tree closes to the driveway is cracked in the center of the tree and now leans towards the house.

69 Chapel St- The tree roots are so bad at this property that they actually have cracked my foundation, and not to mention, have grown above ground creating a tripping hazard. (See attached photo's).

281 Pine St- At this property the tree's branches are right over the roof of my house, the bottom of the tree has deteriorated, which is now leaning towards the house. (See attached photo's).

The tree in front of 179 Park Ave needs to be removed. I have addressed this issue with the city previously several times.

The tree is still having limbs fall whenever we encounter high winds. I have attached pictures relating to my concerns with this tree.

It is now becoming a tripping hazard due to the tree roots that are causing the sidewalk to heave. I cannot fix the sidewalk until the tree is removed and the stump and roots are ground up. I feel this is a big liability that I will not be responsible for. The tree is also leaning towards the road and if it falls the powerlines for the entire street will go with it. The base of the tree is spungie from rot. It is just a matter of time before something seriously happens and God forbid somebody gets hurt.


