- Temperature logs verifying Pathogen Reduction & Vector Attraction are up to date
- Biofilter in good shape
- After time in the bays, the biosolids are place in bunkers under cover and then windrow formed outside. Temperatures taken in windrows for approximately 14 days before piles are sampled as finished product
- Only screens the material from the bunker, not after being outside.
- Only issue of concern -Fire Extinguisher does need to be replaced
