## 2. Fire Responses:

- a. 312 S. Transit "Yes Sir, Yes Ma'am" electrical fire.
- **b. 96 Locust** they have determined that they are not going to salvage, not contest the demolition.
  - Ruled incendiary in nature
- c. **284 Prospect –** in proper disposal of smoking materials. Some smoke inhalation. Fire damage was contained to the living room, but the smoke damage throughout.
- **d. 120 S. New York** electrical current backfeed through cable line all damage contained to single wall cavity.
- e. 30 Webb uncertain of ignition started near rear porch roof.
- f. **626 East Ave –** suspected fireplace/chimney fire no working smoke detectors everyone is ok.

Commissioner Morello stated that he would like to commend both the Fire Chief and MTO for the skills and training provided to the LFD, as they have been unharmed and providing great service.

- 3. LFD Received Red Cross Real Heroes Award 11/02/2023 as a result of the Caves rescue incident back in June.
- 4. Niagara Gazette & Union Sun & Journal booklet did nice interviews/pictures with the Fire & Police Chief
- 5. Karen Gavin to receive to VFW "Citizen Servant" Award delivery of the baby in the back of the ambulance earlier in the year.
- 6. **New Ambulance in service –** 10/24/2023 brand new unit, purchased from Gorman Enterprises in Elma NY, D & T Graphics installed the decaling, the unit (M62) already has 2400 miles on it.

## 7. Ambulance Service Update –

- a. 1944 Transports
- b. 2793 EMS Incidents
- c. 4m 28s average response time
- d. 27,444.5 loaded patient miles
- **e.** Since the new hospital opened, 55% of patients have been transported there, up from 20% previously
- f. Mutual aid: given 122 (Fire and EMS), received 255 times (Fire and EMS)
- **g.** County will be going online with ambulance service 2 ambulances beginning in early to mid-December.
- **8. Stephanie Senn Hired 11/13/2023 –** 2 weeks with the training officer, and then she will be "filling in" until going to fire academy.
- 9. Victor Aikin and Rafel Talaman- Cruz did great and have graduated the academy. They will be assigned to their platoons next week. Aikin set the class record for fastest CPAT time.

**10.Firefighters entrance exam –** January 13, 2024. Deadline is December 11<sup>th</sup>.

LFD Agility test for the current list will be given December 8<sup>th</sup>.

**11. Commissioner Beakman** – concerns brought to the table that he is worried about changes that may come as a result of the newly elected administration. Deeply concerned about Alderman Fogles behavior. Paul read a letter that he shared with Corp Counsel in October.
