


DESCRIPTION OF PRECISE LOCATION AND NATURE OF CONDITION:

The City of Lockport created a drainage issue for the Town and Country Club, 717 East Avenue, Lockport, NY, when it designed and allowed water from the Colonial Meadows subdivision to drain onto property located at 707 East Avenue, Lockport, NY, which adjoins the Town and Country Club, Inc. property. Attached hereto as Exhibit 1 is a Wendel dye test map showing the Town of Lockport New York water drainage from Carlisle Gardens subdivision across the Town and Country's property. Also shown in yellow on Exhibit 1 is the City of Lockport's Colonial Meadows subdivision drainage from Priscilla Lane underground and across East Avenue into property known as 707 East Avenue, Lockport, NY. Said city's water drainage from beneath East Avenue makes entry unto 707 East Avenue, Lockport, NY, by right of way recorded in the Niagara County Clerk's Office March 29, 1957 in Liber 1253 of Deeds at page 78 given by Gladys W. Marshall.


Attached as Exhibit 2 is a map of the right of way granted by Gladys W. Marshall to the city in March of 1957. This right of way creates a small ravine or separation between 707 East Avenue and 717 East Avenue. No right of way exists between the City of Lockport and the Town and Country Club, Inc. Shown in blue on Exhibit 1 is the approximate location of this ravine. Periodically the ravine fills up with water, silt, debris and overflows onto the 18th green, the surrounding sand traps, fairway and pond of the Town and Country Club, Inc. A private drainage pipe acts as a conduit to funnel some of the water into the existing pond creating an issue of the pond's ability to retain the water/debris/silt/etc. The pond now has become full and the retaining walls face fatigue

which could create a catastrophic wall collapse damaging other fairways, greens, and buildings owned by the Town and Country Club, Inc. The Town and Country Club, Inc. will now be forced to drain and remove the buildup of items from the pond in front of the tee area on the 18th fairway. The west end tile of the said drain has previously become clogged and broke causing damage to the said sand traps, fairway, and pond. The Town and Country Club, Inc. sustained damage and repair costs of approximately \$17,800.00. Simple stop-gap repairs do not remedy the problem. The Town and Country Club, Inc. does not want to cut off or dam up the private drain as this may cause backup damage to houses in the Colonial Meadows subdivision.

The Town and Country Club would want the City of Lockport to design and implement a plan to drain the ravine and establish and maintain a pipeline which would prevent further damage to the said fairway, sand traps and pond by permanently diverting said water, debris, silt etc. Otherwise, the Town and Country Club, Inc. will continue to sustain damage either by flooding or failure of the pond's infrastructure and costs to remedy the same.







The New York State Department of Transportation (NYSDOT) is in the preliminary design phases of the above-referenced, federally funded transportation project to rehabilitate NY Route 78 between Millersport Highway and Summit Street. The project proposes improvements to the roadway, pedestrian facilities and deficient drainage along the route.

The project proposes the reconstruction of an existing sidewalk and a new ADA compliant curb ramp along the eastern side of NY Route 78 (Transit Road) directly in front of Childrens Memorial Park. This reconstruction will require the permanent acquisition (FEE) of approximately 1997 square feet of Right-of-Way (ROW) from Childrens Memorial Park (see enclosure). The acquisition will not interfere with park activities and access to the park will remain open throughout the duration of construction activities. The acquisition of public parkland for use in transportation projects is regulated by Section 4(f) of the US Department of Transportation Act of 1966 (Act). Furthermore, the 2005 revision of the Act established procedures for states to acquire minor amounts of ROW through Eminent Domain Procedure Law from public parklands as a *de minimis* use.

NYSDOT will be requesting that the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) consider this action be considered a *de minimis* use. As regulated under Section 4(f), and as part of the *de minimis* determination, NYSDOT must obtain a letter from the Official with Jurisdiction and solicit public comment on the 4(f) action before obtaining *de minimis* concurrence from FHWA.

As the rightful owner of the property, the City of Lockport is considered the Section 4(f) Official with Jurisdiction. After the City has reviewed this action and allowed the public an opportunity for comment**, NYSDOT respectfully requests an "Official with Jurisdiction" letter stating whether the City agrees or disagrees with the de

minimis determination. If the City agrees with the action (FEE acquisition) and the *de minimis* determination, NYSDOT asks that the City provide a letter to NYSDOT with the following text included:

"The City of Lockport has no objections to the de minimis determination of the proposed action (acquisition of approximately 1997 square feet of ROW) from Childrens Memorial Park and that this action will not adversely impact the activities, features, and attributes that qualify this property (Childrens Memorial Park) for protection under the Department of Transportation Act of 1966, Section 4(f)."
