BOND ORDINANCE DATED MAY 22, 2024.

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF AN ADDITIONAL \$1,362,000 BONDS OF THE CITY OF LOCKPORT, NIAGARA COUNTY, NEW YORK, TO PAY PART OF THE COST OF THE GULF INTERCEPTOR SEWER PROJECT, IN AND FOR SAID CITY.

Whereas the capital project hereinafter described has been determined to be a Type II Action pursuant to 6 NYCRR Part 617.5(c)(1) and (2) of the regulations of the New York State Department of Environmental Conservation promulgated pursuant to the State Environmental Quality Review Act, the implementation of which as proposed, such regulations provide, will not result in any significant adverse environmental impact; and

Whereas it is now desired to authorize additional bonds for the financing thereof, **Now, therefore,**

Be it ordained, by the affirmative vote of not less than two-thirds of the total voting strength of the Common Council of the City of Lockport, Niagara County, New York, as follows:

<u>Section 1.</u> For the specific object or purpose of paying additional costs of the Gulf Sewer Interceptor Sewer Project, including original furnishings, equipment, apparatus, appurtenances, and incidental improvements and expenses in connection therewith, in and for the City of Lockport, Niagara County, New York, there are hereby authorized to be issued an additional \$1,362,000 bonds pursuant to the provisions of the Local Finance Law. Said

specific object or purpose is hereby authorized at a revised maximum estimated cost of \$9,100,000.

Section 2. The plan for the financing of such \$9,100,000 maximum estimated cost is as follows:

- a) By the issuance of the \$7,738,000 bonds of said City heretofore authorized to be issued therefor pursuant to a bond ordinance dated and duly adopted November 17, 2021; and
- b) By the issuance of the additional \$1,362,000 bonds of said City herein authorized. The amount of obligations authorized to be issued shall not be reduced by any State and/or Federal grants-in-aid to be received by said City for said purpose, and the bond ordinance dated and duly adopted November 17, 2021 is hereby amended accordingly.

<u>Section 3.</u> It is hereby determined that the period of probable usefulness of the aforesaid specific object or purpose is forty years, pursuant to subdivision 4 of paragraph a of Section 11.00 of the Local Finance Law, calculated from the date of issuance of the first obligations issued therefore.

<u>Section 4.</u> The faith and credit of said City of Lockport, Niagara County, New York, are hereby irrevocably pledged for the payment of the principal of and interest on such obligations as the same respectively become due and payable. An annual appropriation shall be made in each year sufficient to pay the principal of and interest on such obligations becoming due and payable in such year. There shall annually be levied on all the taxable real property of said City, a tax sufficient to pay the principal of and interest on such obligations as the same become due and payable.

<u>Section 5.</u> Subject to the provisions of the Local Finance Law, the power to authorize the issuance of and to sell bond anticipation notes in anticipation of the issuance and sale of the bonds herein authorized, including renewals of such notes, is hereby delegated to the City Treasurer, the chief fiscal officer. Such notes shall be of such terms, form and contents, and shall be sold in such manner, as may be prescribed by said City Treasurer, consistent with the provisions of the Local Finance Law.

<u>Section 6.</u> Such bonds shall be in fully registered form and shall be signed in the name of the City of Lockport, Niagara County, New York, by the manual or facsimile signature of the City Treasurer and a facsimile of its corporate seal shall be imprinted or impressed thereon and may be attested by the manual or facsimile signature of the City Clerk.

<u>Section 7.</u> The powers and duties of advertising such bonds for sale, conducting the sale and awarding the bonds, are hereby delegated to the City Treasurer, who shall advertise such bonds for sale, conduct the sale, and award the bonds in such manner as the City Treasurer shall deem best for the interests of said City; provided, however, that in the exercise of these delegated powers, the City Treasurer shall comply fully with the provisions of the Local Finance Law and any order or rule of the State Comptroller applicable to the sale of municipal bonds. The receipt of the City Treasurer shall be a full acquittance to the purchaser of such bonds, who shall not be obliged to see to the application of the purchase money.

<u>Section 8.</u> All other matters, except as provided herein relating to such bonds herein authorized including date, denominations, maturities, interest payment dates, and whether said bonds shall be repaid in accordance with a schedule providing for substantially level or declining annual debt service, within the limitations prescribed herein and the manner of execution of the same and also including the consolidation with other issues, shall be

determined by the City Treasurer, the chief fiscal officer of such City. Such bonds shall contain substantially the recital of validity clause provided for in section 52.00 of the Local Finance Law and shall otherwise be in such form and contain such recitals in addition to those required by section 52.00 of the Local Finance Law, as the City Treasurer shall determine consistent with the provisions of the Local Finance Law.

Section 9. This ordinance shall constitute a statement of official intent for purposes of Treasury Regulations Section 1.150-2. Other than as specified in this ordinance, no monies are, or are reasonably expected to be, reserved, allocated on a long-term basis, or otherwise set aside with respect to the permanent funding of the object or purpose described herein.

<u>Section 10.</u> The City Treasurer is hereby further authorized, at her sole discretion, to execute a project finance and loan agreement, and any other agreements with the New York State Department of Environmental Conservation and/or the New York State Environmental Facilities Corporation, including amendments thereto, and including any instruments (or amendments thereto) in the effectuation thereof, in order to effect the financing or refinancing of the specific object or purpose described in Section 1 hereof, or a portion thereof, by a bond, and/or note issue of said City in the event of the sale of same to the New York State Environmental Facilities Corporation.

<u>Section 11.</u> The power to issue and sell notes for said specific object or purpose to the New York State Environmental Facilities Corporation pursuant to Section 169.00 of the Local Finance Law is hereby delegated to the City Treasurer. Such notes shall be of such terms, form and contents as may be prescribed by said City Treasurer consistent with the provisions of the Local Finance Law.

Section 12. The validity of such bonds and bond anticipation notes may be contested only if:

- 1) Such obligations are authorized for an object or purpose for which said City is not authorized to expend money, or
- 2) The provisions of law which should be complied with at the date of publication of this ordinance are not substantially complied with, and an action, suit or proceeding contesting such validity is commenced within twenty days after the date of such publication, or
- 3) Such obligations are authorized in violation of the provisions of the Constitution.

<u>Section 13.</u> This ordinance, which takes effect immediately, shall be published in summary form in the official newspaper, together with a notice of the City Clerk in substantially the form provided in Section 81.00 of the Local Finance Law.



Ms. Lanzo,

I am requesting the city reimburse me \$427.11 for the damage to my vehicle caused due to the faulty repair of Lincoln Ave by the water department (or it's contractor) after fixing a water line problem.

The hole is on the north (city) side of Lincoln Ave approximately 20 yards from the Beattie Ave intersection. It is a very deep narrow gap between the existing pavement and the repaired section of the road. It is extremely hard to see as you are driving. It's obvious the hole was not filled and compacted correctly by the city causing this deep hole.

I hit the hole on Tuesday, April 16th. I did call the city highway department that day to report the dangerous situation. On Thursday, April 18th the water department placed a large piece of steel to cover the hole, along with barrels to warn traffic.

My truck was just inspected in January. The right front was thoroughly checked and was perfect, I had to replace a wheel bearing to pass inspection. This hole caused my front right stabilizer bar link to break, plus it will require a wheel alignment.

Please respond as soon as possible, I'd like to get this fixed soon so that we don't have an additional expense of the tire being destroyed due to the damage.

I have attached copies of the repair estimate, documentation of the bad alignment and pictures of the location and the newly placed barrels.

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE, that the claimant, PRISCILA SEPULVEDA, (hereinafter "Claimant"), submits this Claim against the CITY OF LOCKPORT, (hereinafter "Respondent"), and in support of said claim states the following:

- The address of Claimant is 9901 Niagara Falls Boulevard, Apt. 33, Niagara Falls,
 New York 14304.
- The Attorneys for Claimant are The Coppola Firm, PLLC, David M. Goodman,
 Esq. Of Counsel, 4033 Maple Road, Suite 100, Buffalo, New York 14226.
 - This claim arose on June 12, 2023, at 5 Gooding St., Lockport, New York 14094.
 - 4. Claimant attended a guided tour of the Erie Canal and the Lockport Locks.
- 5. The guided tour was performed by Hydraulic Race Company, Inc., d/b/a Lockport Cave & Underground Boat Ride.

- The tour began at the ticket office of Lockport Cave & Underground Boat Ride,
 which is located at 5 Gooding St., Lockport, New York 14094.
- As part of the tour, guests attended a "Boat Ride" in furtherance of the historical tour.
- 8. It was Claimant's understanding that the boat ride would venture into the cave, and once at the end, would reverse and return back to the starting point.
- 9. On June 12, 2023, during the boating portion of the tour, at approximately 11:30 a.m., the boat became unbalanced and capsized, sending the Claimant and Claimant's fellow passengers into the freezing water below.
- 10. Upon information and belief, the incident herein described, and the resultant damages sustained were caused as a result of the negligence, carelessness, recklessness, and deliberate indifference on the part of the agents, servants, and/or employees of the City of Lockport. These acts include, but are not limited to, the following:
 - a. Negligent supervision;
 - b. Negligent failure to recognize a known danger;
 - Negligent failure to take proper measures to correct the danger;
 - d. Negligent failure to inspect the tour boat;
 - Negligent failure to license the tour boat;
 - f. Negligently failing to prevent injuries;
 - g. The Respondents were otherwise negligent.
- 12. Upon information and belief, the City of Lockport Police confirmed a similar incident to Lockport Cave & Boat Ride. Upon information and belief, an incident report was filed in the department.

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15. Upon information and belief, Respondent had the duty to inspect, and issue

permits to Lockport Cave & Underground Boat Ride but failed to do so which resulted in

serious bodily injuries and severe emotional distress.

16. That as a result of the capsize of the boat and being thrown into the freezing

water along with my fellow passengers, Claimant has suffered both physical and

psychological injuries for which Claimant continues to seek treatment.

17. Upon information and belief, the incident herein described, and the resultant

damages sustained were caused as a result of the negligence, carelessness, recklessness, and

deliberate indifference on the part of the agents, servants, and/or employees of Respondents,

both jointly and severally, without any comparative fault attributable to Claimant.

WHEREFORE, Claimant requests compensation from Respondents along with such

other and further relief as may be awarded by the Court, including but not limited to costs

and attorneys' fees incurred herein, and for such other and further relief as to the Court may

seem just and proper.

ADDITIONAL MONEY BOND ORDINANCE

(GULF INTERCEPTOR SEWER PROJECT)

BOND ORDINANCE DATED MAY 22, 2024.

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF AN ADDITIONAL \$1,362,000 BONDS OF THE CITY OF LOCKPORT, NIAGARA COUNTY, NEW YORK, TO PAY PART OF THE COST OF THE GULF INTERCEPTOR SEWER PROJECT, IN AND FOR SAID CITY.

WHEREAS, the capital project hereinafter described has been determined to be a Type II Action pursuant to 6 NYCRR Part 617.5(c)(1) and (2) of the regulations of the New York State Department of Environmental Conservation promulgated pursuant to the State Environmental Quality Review Act, the implementation of which as proposed, such regulations provide, will not result in any significant adverse environmental impact; and

WHEREAS, it is now desired to authorize additional bonds for the financing thereof, NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED, by the affirmative vote of not less than two-thirds of the total voting strength of the Common Council of the City of Lockport, Niagara County, New York, as follows:

Sever Interceptor Sewer Project, including original furnishings, equipment, apparatus, appurtenances, and incidental improvements and expenses in connection therewith, in and for the City of Lockport, Niagara County, New York, there are hereby authorized to be issued an additional \$1,362,000 bonds pursuant to the provisions of the Local Finance Law. Said specific object or purpose is hereby authorized at a revised maximum estimated cost of \$9,100,000.

Section 2. The plan for the financing of such \$9,100,000 maximum estimated cost is as follows:

- a) By the issuance of the \$7,738,000 bonds of said City heretofore authorized to be issued therefor pursuant to a bond ordinance dated and duly adopted November 17, 2021; and
- b) By the issuance of the additional \$1,362,000 bonds of said City herein authorized. The amount of obligations authorized to be issued shall not be reduced by any State and/or Federal grants-in-aid to be received by said City for said purpose, and the bond ordinance dated and duly adopted November 17, 2021 is hereby amended accordingly.

Section 3. It is hereby determined that the period of probable usefulness of the aforesaid specific object or purpose is forty years, pursuant to subdivision 4 of paragraph a of Section 11.00 of the Local Finance Law, calculated from the date of issuance of the first obligations issued therefore.

Section 4. The faith and credit of said City of Lockport, Niagara County, New York, are hereby irrevocably pledged for the payment of the principal of and interest on such obligations as the same respectively become due and payable. An annual appropriation shall be made in each year sufficient to pay the principal of and interest on such obligations becoming due and payable in such year. There shall annually be levied on all the taxable real property of said City, a tax sufficient to pay the principal of and interest on such obligations as the same become due and payable.

Section 5. Subject to the provisions of the Local Finance Law, the power to authorize the issuance of and to sell bond anticipation notes in anticipation of the issuance and sale of the bonds herein authorized, including renewals of such notes, is hereby delegated to the City Treasurer, the chief fiscal officer. Such notes shall be of such terms, form and contents, and shall

be sold in such manner, as may be prescribed by said City Treasurer, consistent with the provisions of the Local Finance Law.

Section 6. Such bonds shall be in fully registered form and shall be signed in the name of the City of Lockport, Niagara County, New York, by the manual or facsimile signature of the City Treasurer and a facsimile of its corporate seal shall be imprinted or impressed thereon and may be attested by the manual or facsimile signature of the City Clerk.

Section 7. The powers and duties of advertising such bonds for sale, conducting the sale and awarding the bonds, are hereby delegated to the City Treasurer, who shall advertise such bonds for sale, conduct the sale, and award the bonds in such manner as the City Treasurer shall deem best for the interests of said City; provided, however, that in the exercise of these delegated powers, the City Treasurer shall comply fully with the provisions of the Local Finance Law and any order or rule of the State Comptroller applicable to the sale of municipal bonds. The receipt of the City Treasurer shall be a full acquittance to the purchaser of such bonds, who shall not be obliged to see to the application of the purchase money.

Section 8. All other matters, except as provided herein relating to such bonds herein authorized including date, denominations, maturities, interest payment dates, and whether said bonds shall be repaid in accordance with a schedule providing for substantially level or declining annual debt service, within the limitations prescribed herein and the manner of execution of the same and also including the consolidation with other issues, shall be determined by the City Treasurer, the chief fiscal officer of such City. Such bonds shall contain substantially the recital of validity clause provided for in section 52.00 of the Local Finance Law and shall otherwise be in such form and contain such recitals in addition to those required by section 52.00 of the Local

Finance Law, as the City Treasurer shall determine consistent with the provisions of the Local Finance Law.

Section 9. This ordinance shall constitute a statement of official intent for purposes of Treasury Regulations Section 1.150-2. Other than as specified in this ordinance, no monies are, or are reasonably expected to be, reserved, allocated on a long-term basis, or otherwise set aside with respect to the permanent funding of the object or purpose described herein.

Section 10. The City Treasurer is hereby further authorized, at her sole discretion, to execute a project finance and loan agreement, and any other agreements with the New York State Department of Environmental Conservation and/or the New York State Environmental Facilities Corporation, including amendments thereto, and including any instruments (or amendments thereto) in the effectuation thereof, in order to effect the financing or refinancing of the specific object or purpose described in Section 1 hereof, or a portion thereof, by a bond, and/or note issue of said City in the event of the sale of same to the New York State Environmental Facilities Corporation.

Section 11. The power to issue and sell notes for said specific object or purpose to the New York State Environmental Facilities Corporation pursuant to Section 169.00 of the Local Finance Law is hereby delegated to the City Treasurer. Such notes shall be of such terms, form and contents as may be prescribed by said City Treasurer consistent with the provisions of the Local Finance Law.

Section 12. The validity of such bonds and bond anticipation notes may be contested only if:

 Such obligations are authorized for an object or purpose for which said City is not authorized to expend money, or

- 2) The provisions of law which should be complied with at the date of publication of this ordinance are not substantially complied with, and an action, suit or proceeding contesting such validity is commenced within twenty days after the date of such publication, or
 - 3) Such obligations are authorized in violation of the provisions of the Constitution.

Section 13. This ordinance, which takes effect immediately, shall be published in summary form in the official newspaper, together with a notice of the City Clerk in substantially the form provided in Section 81.00 of the Local Finance Law.
