He said that they would like to update that to free the flow of traffic into the plaza so that they are not stopping traffic on So. Transit.

Commissioner Harmon said that the drawings shows a chain link fence around the play area. He asked if there is still going to be traffic from the east and west.

Dave stated that there won't be any thru traffic, just parking for the daycare employees.

Commissioner Harmon asked if they are going to install bollards around the fence in case there is incident.

Dave stated that there are protective bollards at the corners of the parking lot where it curves. He said that they can look into installing more in the play area fence.

Commissioner Harmon said they should be installed on the east and west sides in case a car go through the fence.
