The meeting of the Lockport Planning Board was called to order at 5:00 P.M. at the Lockport Municipal Building, One Locks Plaza, Lockport, New York.

1. Bob Timkey. 1149 Lincoln Avenue. Request to install 152 roof mounted solar panels on the west side of the building situated in a B-1 Zone.

Mr. Timkey stated that he is the owner of Go Solar located in Lockport. He said that this is a roof mounted solar array. He said that this would be a large array on a home but considered a small commercial array. He said that there will be 152 solar panels that will be flush mounted on the west side of the building. He said that this is the old Crafts and Creations building. He said that the panels will be on the side of the building facing Kenyon's. He said that these will be flush mounted black panels with micro invertors. He said that there will be 152 micro invertor, one under each panel. He said that he likes this system because it is safer, using less voltage.

Mr. Timkey said that this is a simple install. He said that they will be onsite for about two weeks total. He said that they plan on starting at the end of July, beginning of August. He said that the electrician will be performing a service upgrade. He said that they will be on roof about three days.

Commissioner Bragg asked if there is a glare concern.

Mr. Timkey said that ground mounted array's usually have more concern for glare. He said that because these are flush mounted and the roof has a 1/15 pitch the panels will not be on an angle. He said that he doesn't expect glare to be an issue.

Commissioner Tracy asked what the roof color is now.

Mr. Timkey said that it is a raw steel roof and the panels will be matte black.

Commissioner Tracy asked if there are going to be wall mounted packs.

Mr. Timkey said that they will be inside the gated area on the southwest side of the building. He said there is already a generator and air handlers inside the area. He said that they will all be on the same wall.

The meeting was opened to the public.

The meeting was closed to the public.

There being nothing further Commissioner Roth made a motion to approve the request to install 152 roof mounted solar panels on the west side of the building. Seconded by Commissioner Allport.
