

Lockport Community Pool Rules:

****** It is a privilege to swim in the Lockport Community Pool, please follow the rules, be respectful and have fun!******

1. No running or fast walking on the pool deck.
2. No diving in the shallow end.
3. No pushing, shoving, splashing, dunking, holding or getting on someone's shoulders or back.
4. No running and diving or jumping into the deep or shallow end.
5. In the showers we are using soap once, when you are done with the pool.
6. No toilet paper wads in the locker room. You will be required to clean up the wads as community service work for destroying property. Possibly banned from premises.
7. Need to take the deep end test every day.
8. There is no congregating into the locker rooms unless you are getting dressed. You are here to swim.
9. No eating in locker rooms.
10. No twist, turns, flips, belly flops or backward entries into the pool. Feet first entry from the side of the pool.
11. Jump from the edge of the pool only.
12. No smoking or vaping on premises
13. Pick up your garbage after eating or drinking
14. No swearing
15. No racist card used against any staff. 1st verbal 2nd week off and 3rd for the summer.
16. No life jackets/floatation in the deep end.
17. If you take off any tile in the pool you will be out of the pool for a couple of days, then weeks and for the summer.
18. Be respectful to all staff whether you agree or disagree with what they say.
19. Keep personal opinions to yourself and mind your own business when it comes to staff discipline of other patrons.
20. Children under the age of 5 years are not allowed to be with an older sibling, parents only.
21. No footballs allowed
22. Do not take anything out of the First Aid room, first please ask a staff member in the Snack Shack or Office.

23. This page needs to be signed by all family members including parents, children age 6 and up.

If you break any of these rules which are in place for your safety or if you argue or do not listen to staff members you will be subject to dismissal from the premises for a couple of days, then weeks and finally for the summer or permanently.

Print and sign your name to acknowledge the pool rules. Parents need to be present for the **first time** children are dropped off to the pool.
