**Chief's Report**

1. Chief Quagliano expresses his gratitude to Commissioner Sienna Marren and Alderman Craig for their service to the Fire Board.
2. Chief Quagliano welcomes newcomers Alderman Wiley and Commissioner Eggert to the Fire Board of Commissioners.

3. 2<sup>nd</sup> Alarm Incidents

364 Hawley- Fire was knocked down inside of 15 minutes and was contained to the 2<sup>nd</sup> Floor. Approximately 2000 gallons of water used.

45 Ontario- Fire was mainly contained to the bedroom of origin. One victim suffered 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> degree burns and sadly did not survive after being transported and treated at ECMC. Approximately 50 gallons of water used.

216 West Ave- 3 unit building, 7 people evacuated. The building has been deemed a total loss due to extensive damage.

4. 2025 2<sup>nd</sup> Alarm Incidents – 10 total, no total losses

5. Year End Data/Reports for 2025 – 4672 total incidents, record low overtime use for the department and ambulance revenue exceeded the budgeted prediction.

6. New recruit – Starts Fire Academy 1/8, doing very well so far.

8. Old Ladder truck and Old Chiefs car sold.

Commissioner Nemi suggested the department look at operating with civilian drivers in some capacity. Chief Quagliano did not support that suggestion and advised those kinds of changes were not the prevue of the Fire Board and would need to be negotiated between the Common Council, Mayor & Fire Union. Union President Scapelliti also advised he would not support such an endeavor.
